

NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH WHAT TO DO LIST

OVERVIEW

Neighborhood Watch is sponsored by the Sheriff's Dept. One of the major benefits in this program is the routine drive-thru of the Volunteers who make up the Sheriff's Assist Team in an official Sheriff car. They are volunteers and not armed. They are eyes for our neighborhood. They get accustomed to what is "normal" here and if they see something that looks unusual, they call someone. And they are a great visual deterrent. Also, if you are going to be away from home and want to have them keep an eye on your home, call **(SEACOM) SouthEast Arizona Command (520) 803-3550**.

The other important part of Neighborhood Watch is you and me. Get accustomed to what is "normal" around you and if you see something suspicious. I.E. if your neighbor is on vacation and a moving van pulls up in your neighbors' driveway - call them—or contact the Sheriff's Dept at **(SEACOM) South East Arizona Command (520) 803-3550**. **SEACOM is the new dispatch for the Sheriff's Dept Cochise County**. It's important for us to keep an eye out for each other and help each other out.

HINTS: If there is a pile of newspapers laying in a driveway, a package sitting by the front door, etc. etc. - the message it sends is "Hey, come on in and help yourself—no-one is home." If you're going away, stop your paper or have someone pick it up for you and have someone check for package deliveries.

IN THE CASE OF ILLEGALS IN OUR NEIGHBORHOOD:

1. Do NOT confront them. Do NOT let them see you pick up your cell phone. Turn your back and walk or drive away. When you are safely out of sight, call the **Border Patrol 520-432-5121** and report as much information as you know.
2. Call **Brigitte Calderwood 480-338-7589**. I will send out an e-mail to all participants and give as much detail as you tell me.

IN THE CASE OF WILD ANIMAL SITINGS (mountain lion, bear, etc)

1. If you are actually seeing the animal, first do NOT approach it. Go to a safe location. Call Game & Fish @ **800-352-0700** or **520-628-3576** and report it.
2. Call **Brigitte Calderwood 480-338-7589**. I will send out an e-mail to all participants and give as much detail as you tell me.
3. Snake Removal: **520-458-3311**

IN CASE YOU GET A CALL FROM SOMEONE AT THE GATE WANTING YOU TO OPEN THE GATE FOR THEM:

DO NOT open the gate to anyone you do not know **PERSONALLY**. And please **DO NOT** give out your gate code.

REMINDER: If you notice some of the above mentioned situations, and it doesn't really bother you, **PLEASE call me anyway** so I can let other neighbors know. Even if it doesn't bother you, **there may be other neighbors who would like to know**.

Please keep this "What To Do List" in a place where you can locate it if the need arises.
